

# The China Project



Dr. William Tsui, Director of China Ministry Development for Trans World Radio, explains why Mrs. G's Bible stories are urgently needed in China.

#### **Sunday schools**

For many years, the government of China did not allow anyone to share the Gospel message with children and young people under the age of 18 years old. But this restriction has been gradually loosened. Children's Sunday schools are being allowed in many churches (though they might not call them Sunday schools). Also, Children's Sunday school materials are being printed inside China.

### "Stay behind children"

Since parents have to go to the city to work, many children are left behind at home, and these are being called the "Stay behind children". Christians take care of these children. Churches provide programs to help these children and, whenever possible, share Bible teachings with them.

### **Christian parents**

Christian parents want to bring up their children in Christ. Some parents have accepted Christ overseas and have returned to China. These are first-generation Christians. Of course, most parents have always lived in China. Some are first-generation Christians and others have been Christians for generations.

All these groups need good biblical material to share with the children about God and the Christian faith.

Mrs. G's stories, with the questions after the stories, will be a very effective tool to reach and teach these children. Church pastors, children's workers and Christian parents will be delighted to have this wonderful and powerful tool for their ministry to their children.

Many have heard about this project—Bible Stories Alive in Chinese—and are already asking how soon they can have the stories in Mandarin so that they can use them as soon as possible. The demand is already there. Once the Chinese version is out, the stories will be greatly welcomed by many in China as well as by Chinese groups overseas.
