Dear Friend,

A happy and blessed Christmas to you! Christmas is a special family time and a special church time. Soon we will be singing, "Joy to the world! The Lord is come."

Every Christmas we place a part of the Christmas story on our weekly broadcast of A Visit with Mrs. G (which circles the globe by radio and Internet).

You will be delighted to hear that the **Christmas Story** (*Jesus the Baby* and *Jesus the Boy*) is on the Internet in **Mandarin** in eBook and audio book formats (www.abstory.org).

The Christmas Story tells all the stories in Matthew 1 and 2, and Luke 1 and 2.

Children love the stories in English, and we

look forward to hearing the responses of children in China.

The stories in Mandarin will now appear on the Internet as each series is completed. The first was *Joseph and His Dreams*. *The Christmas Story* is the second Mandarin series. The next will be *Adam and Eve*, with the stories of Creation, the Fall, and the Promise of a Saviour.

When the Chinese project is completed all the Bible stories (over 450) will be placed in eBook and audio format on a solar-powered tablet, which can be

used everywhere. We pray that God will make these stories a spiritual treasure to Sunday schools and churches, and families and orphanages and "left-behind" children in China.

Updates

Russian

From a Sunday school teacher:

"We would like to express our heartfelt thanks for the Noah children's books we received [in Belarus] for Sunday school ministry in Easter. This book is interesting, full of content, and easily understood by children. The story is not new, but the presentation is totally different. The children gladly read it and are sharing it with their friends."

Chinese

To date we have edited 15 Mrs. G books and TWR Canada have produced these as 12 Chinese books in eBook and audio book formats. Ten of these are now being field-tested in China. The reports will guide the China Team in the production of the remaining books.

Persian

The Persian department of TWR Canada has translated 7 Mrs. G books into Farsi for Iran. They are now translating *Moses the Rescued Baby*. Audio production will begin in 2017. Sunday schools are illegal in Iran, so Bible Stories Alive will be delivered directly to homes by the Internet. Iran is 99 percent Muslim, many of whom are hungry for the truth.



Arabic

One hundred million children in the Middle East need to hear the good news about the true God and the only Saviour, the Lord Jesus.

As never before, Muslims are ready to listen to the Bible. Christians (perhaps 12 million or more) need Bible stories for their children and young people.

TWR Canada has translated and recorded *Joseph and His Dreams*. *Adam and Eve* is now being translated and will be recorded in 2017.

The storyteller is a refugee from Syria, a young mother with two children. "With a heart for children and a voice for radio, she makes the stories come alive in Arabic."
